

Do you use an electric bike or scooter?

Fires started by electric scooters and bikes have injured hundreds of people in the UK. Find out how you can stay fire safe below if you have one, or use the QR code on the right for more information and advice.



- Don't leave your bike or scooter charging overnight.
- Always use the correct charger.
- Don't use batteries that are damaged or faulty.
- Make sure bikes or scooters don't block the exits of your home, including shared spaces like corridors.
- Only use bike or scooters purchased from a reputable seller.



If your bike or scooter starts a fire, call 999 and get out. Make sure you know your escape route, and you have read any fire action notices in your home which tell you what to do in the event of a fire.
