

Fire doors in your home


**Fire door
keep closed**

What is a fire door?

- Fire doors slow the spread of fire and smoke.
- They protect escape routes so you can get out safely.
- Most flat front doors and communal doors are fire doors.



Keep fire doors working

- Never wedge or prop open a fire door.
- Do not remove or change your fire doors (like taking off closers).
- Close all doors at night, even non-fire doors help in a fire.



We check

- Flat front doors once a year.
- Communal doors every 6 months.
- Please allow access so we can keep you safe.



You can check

- Gaps: No more than 4mm at sides and top, 8mm at bottom.
- Seals: No damage around the edges.
- Hinges: Secure and all screws in place.
- Closing: Closes fully on its own and isn't sticking.
